LIBRARY COMPUTERS & PRINTERS—IMPRINTS CARD

ANYONE CAN PRINT FROM A LIBRARY COMPUTER using an Imprints copying and printing card. Copy cards may be bought or charged at the library vending machines or at any Imprints shop on campus.* Printers are located on the first and second floors of Geisel Library, as well as in other campus libraries.

B&W PRINTING	\$.10/page
COLOR PRINTING	\$.50/page

*A \$1 bill is required for the initial purchase of a card from a vending machine. New cards come with a \$.50 credit and may be recharged in any amount. The vending machines accept bills only and do not provide change. Imprints shops accept cash, as well as debit and credit cards, with a \$5 minimum purchase. *Imprints printing and copying cards are nonrefundable.*

PHOTOCOPYING IN THE LIBRARIES

BLACK & WHITE PHOTOCOPIERS are located on every floor of the Geisel Library building, as well as in all the other campus libraries. Copiers require the use of an Imprints card, and copies are \$.10/page for any size paper.

ACADEMIC COMPUTING SERVICES LABS—ACS ACCOUNT

CURRENT UCSD STUDENTS MAY SET UP an ACS laser printing account.* ACS labs are located throughout the campus, as well as in the libraries. If you will be printing frequently on campus, an ACS account is a convenient and economical option. Set up your laser printing account online at acs.ucsd.edu/print.

*An initial deposit of \$10, billed to your UCSD Student Business Services account, is required to establish an ACS printing account. Printing charges are debited from this amount as they are incurred. *Money deposited in a laser printing account is nonrefundable*, however your account remains active from quarter to quarter as long as you are a student at UCSD.
